FETA, SUN-DRIED TOMATO & SPINACH MUFFINS

These are very good for breakfast, packed lunches or picnics

375ml plain flour
10ml baking powder
Pinch of salt
Pinch of nutmeg or cayenne pepper
250ml cooked spinach, chopped
250ml feta cheese, crumbled
8 sun-dried tomatoes, soaked and chopped
100ml milk
100ml oil
1 egg, beaten

Preheat oven to 190C and grease a 12 hollow muffin tin.

Sieve the dry ingredients together.

In a separate bowl, mix the spinach, sun-dried tomatoes, milk, oil and egg. Add to the flour and mix well. Stir in the feta.

Mix until everything is just combined.

Fill the muffin tins $\frac{3}{4}$ full and bake in the oven for 20-25 minutes, until a skewer comes out clean.
